

WHAT WE BELIEVE

Authority of Scripture: We believe the Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, is the inspired Word of God and our final authority in faith and life.

God: We believe the God of the Bible is the only true God. He is infinite, loving, just, omnipotent, omniscient, and unchanging. He exists eternally in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Jesus Christ: We believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin, He was fully God and fully man. His death, burial, and resurrection are the means by which God reconciles the world to Himself.

Holy Spirit: We believe the Holy Spirit is a real person who shares the nature and attributes of God and reveals truth to humanity, transforming and empowering believers to become like Christ.

Sin: We believe sin is disobedience to God and failure to live according to His will. Sin has separated all of mankind from God and leads to physical death.

Salvation: We believe every person is lost in his rebellion and unable to change his destiny before God. However, God has made a way of salvation through Jesus Christ. A person comes into a right relationship with God by His grace, through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

The Church: We believe the Church is a spiritual body which consists of believers in Christ. Local congregations of believers come together to live out their faith through worship, spiritual formation, and service.

Ordinances: We believe there are two Biblical ordinances. Baptism by immersion is a public expression to the world of a believer's personal faith in Jesus Christ. The Lord's Supper is a communal meal which reinforces our faith in Jesus Christ for His atoning work and our assurance of His return.

Return of Jesus Christ & Eternity: We believe in the second coming of Jesus Christ. Upon His return, those believers who place their faith in Him will exist eternally with God in righteousness and peace. Those who have continued in unrepentance and unbelief will exist eternally separated from God.

Much like many other churches, our church experienced the loss of several participants after the global pandemic. The live stream participation was strong in the beginning, and then gradually waned. We still have a few that prefer to participate by live stream, but in-person attendance is significantly less than our usual average attendance before the pandemic. We currently see an average of 100 people in our Sunday morning services, compared to 150+ prior to the pandemic.

We're left with a solid group of people who love one another, love the Lord and are regular attenders of Sunday Worship Services. Our congregation is represented in a strong mix of career fields with over half having degrees beyond high school. The majority of our current participants are actively serving in some way.

Having bid farewell to our previous pastor of 20+ years, we look forward to discovering where God will lead us next.

ABOUT THE PFBC FACILITIES

Originally founded in 1866, Peru First Baptist Church is celebrating over 150 years of reaching the Peru community and beyond for Jesus. Our building is ideally located in the center of Peru, just a block from the Miami County Courthouse and the Main and Broadway intersection.

Beautiful stained-glass windows adorn the semi-circular sanctuary, which can seat over 500 people. It includes a baptistry just behind the altar. Also available on site are: a smaller chapel, a Youth Center, a Welcome Center, sufficient office spaces, multiple conference rooms and classrooms, a library, childcare nurseries, two kitchens, two fellowship halls, many of which are located in an annex building connected to the original church building.

An elevator provides access to all three levels of the church structure and annex building. The parking lot is conveniently available behind the building, with additional handicap spaces surrounding the building itself nearest the elevator. A fenced outdoor patio area facing Main Street is adjacent to the annex building, suitable for outdoor gatherings or seasonal outreach functions.
